Announcements

Kathy announced a monthly training collaborative with the VA that OhioMHAS is preparing to facilitate. The training will center around Substance Use Disorders.

Michael announced that there is a HRSA Grant for counselors to receive stipends to add training in the field. He also announced on March 2, 2019 the Cincinnati School of Medicine is hosting an Opioid Summit and on 4/12/ 2019 there will be an Integrated Care forum around MAT.

The Committee began by discussing the option of offering a specialized endorsement in Medication Assisted Treatment. The Committee agreed on the value of highlighting education opportunities for Medication Assisted Treatment but did not want to move forward with an endorsement. The Committee will continue discussing ways to support MAT education to the field.

Bachelors Level Curriculum Review

Committee discussed reviewing Bachelor curriculums to make sure they align with the Boards education requirements. The Committee decided that Practicums should be a requirement of the Review. The Committee was satisfied with a few minor corrections the Curriculum Review will be ready to disseminate.

Director Updates

A.Clark. presented the Executive Director's Update. Alisia informed the committee that the SFY17, 18 Audit is still in process and will be completed within the next month. The Board has hired a new staff member. She stated the processing time for applications continues to be 40 business days. A. Clark stated the Board office has received 1,024 applications in the first quarter of SFY19. She stated the renewal process has changed with the inclusion of the additional MEDTAPP questions.

A. Clark provided a brief rule update. The new prevention scope of practice has been filed with JCARR the Public Hearing is scheduled for October 24, 2018. The volunteer rules and the

updated examination remediation rules were also filed. The treatment scope of practice rules is in review by the Treatment Committee and will be updated and submitted to the Board for a vote.

A. Clark is working with T.Sullivan to begin developing a marketing plan. G. Hogg offered to assist with the marketing project. G. Hogg suggested that the Executive Committee consider making the marketing plan a subcommittee.

Board Sponsored Training

Greg H. suggested that the Committee develop a sub committee to review the need to develop competencies for an Ethics Training.

Rules Update

Alisia C. discussed the rule update in the Directors report.

IC&RC Domain Alignment

Alisia C. reviewed the law and rules and the IC&RC domains appear in the rules. The Committee discussed rewriting the rules.

Work Plan

The committee updated the work plan with new target dates.
