

# Crosswalk Table Summarizing Veterans' Pathway to Licensure/Certification

The Board recognizes that certain military programs of training and military specialties are substantially equivalent to and therefore meet training and work experience requirements for certification/licensure with the Board.

The following is a summary of military credentials in the field of chemical dependency counseling and prevention and how those credentials equate to a license or certificate with the Board.
